¹¹ For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, ¹² training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, ¹³ waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

How are we being trained up?

1. **Grace appeared** (v11)

saving us

training us (v12)

- to renounce ungodliness
- to live in godliness

2. **While we wait for Jesus to appear again...** (v13)

...remember that he gave himself for us: (v14)

to redeem us

to purify us

...because we are his people

...who are zealous for good works

So, look back to grace, look forward in hope and be zealous for good works.
