

"God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." James 4:6 (ESV)

James 4:1-10 (ESV)



4 What causes quarrels and what causes fights among you? Is it not this, that your passions are at war within you? ² You desire and do not have, so you murder. You covet and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel. You do not have, because you do not ask. ³ You ask

and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. ⁴You adulterous people! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. ⁵Or do you suppose it is to no purpose that the Scripture says, "He yearns jealously over the spirit that he has made to dwell in us"? ⁶But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." ⁷Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. ⁸Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. ⁹Be wretched and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. ¹⁰Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.

The background issue is doublemindedness (James 1:8; 4:8)

1. Double mindedness is adultery (v1-6)

... trying to be friends with the world and friends with God

But you can't serve both God ... and something else (as Jesus says in Matthew 6:24)

- 2. Humble yourself before the Lord (v6-10)
 - o come back (v7b-8a)
 - o be clean (v8)
 - o cry about it (v9)
