

1 Corinthians 1:1-17



Paul, called by the will of God to be an apostle of Christ Jesus, and our brother Sosthenes,

²To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours:

³Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

⁴I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, ⁵ that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge— ⁶ even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you— ⁷ so that you are not lacking in any spiritual gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁸ who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹ God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

¹⁰ I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgement. ¹¹ For it has been reported to me by Chloe's people that there is quarrelling among you, my brothers. ¹² What I mean is that each one of you says, "I follow Paul", or "I follow Apollos", or "I follow Cephas", or "I follow Christ." ¹³ Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? ¹⁴ I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, ¹⁵ so that no one may say that you were baptized in my name. ¹⁶ (I did baptize also the household of Stephanas. Beyond that, I do not know whether I baptized anyone else.) ¹⁷ For Christ did not send me to baptize but to preach the gospel, and not with words of eloquent wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

- 1) Even if your church is seriously messed up...
 - factions (1:12; 3:3-4)
 - sexual immorality "of a kind that is not tolerated even among pagans" (5:1)
 - court cases (6:1)
 - church services that "do more harm than good" (11:17)
 - denial of the resurrection by some (15:12)
- 2) ... you need to know first of all that you are "sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be saints" (v2)...
- 3) ... not to mention gifted, enriched, not lacking in any gift, sure to be sustained until the end, guiltless (vv3-9)
- 4) SORT IT OUT!

How quickly do we reach for God's Grace when we see that we/others need to change?
