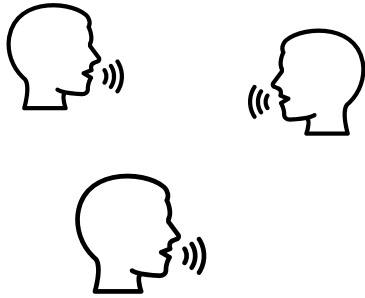


## FIND IT

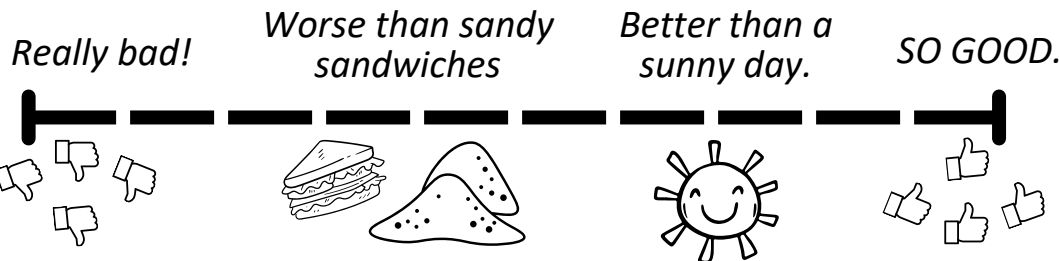

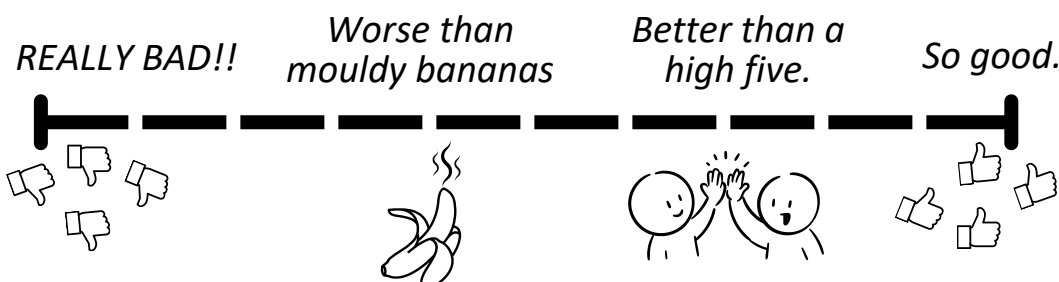
