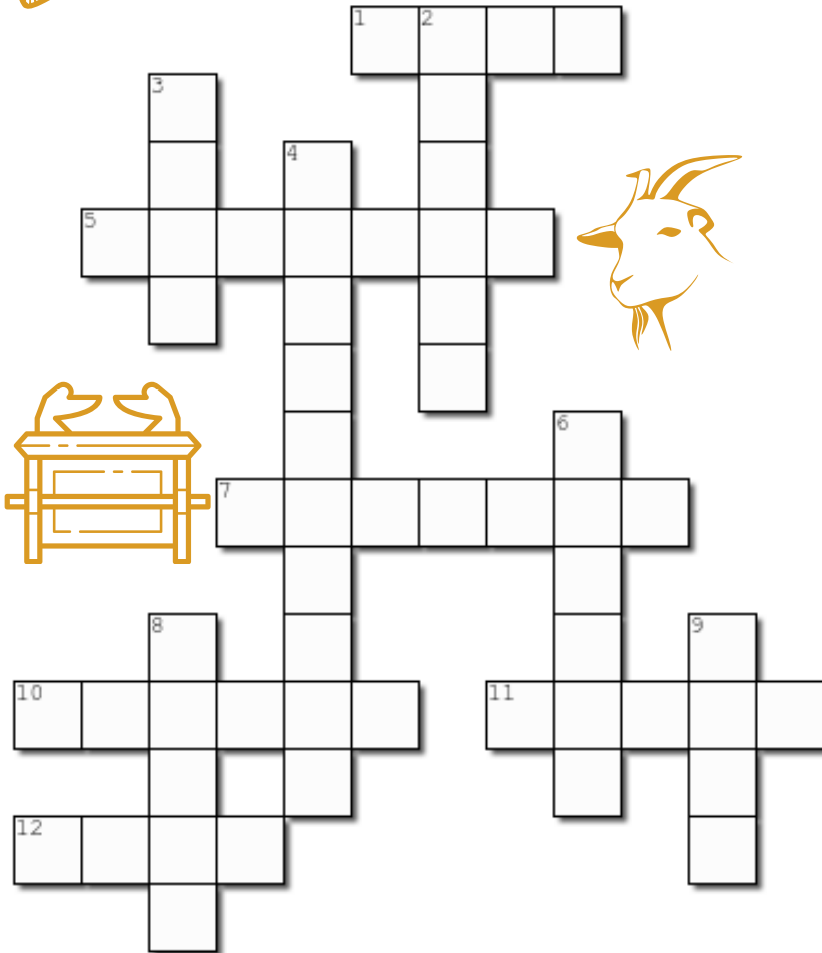
Today's passage: Leviticus 16
