FIND IT OUT

Let's see what the Bible says.



How many men were given the spy mission? **Numbers 13:3-16**

What was their mission? **Numbers 13:17, 20**

Can you draw some of the BIG things they found?? **Verse 27-28**
(Anakites are HUGE STRONG PEOPLE)



WORK IT OUT

Let's put our thinking caps on.

How did the 10 spies feel about fighting BIG PEOPLE? **Numbers 13:31-33**



Wait, but what had God already promised them?
(He also made the same promise to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob!!) **Numbers 13:1-2**

How did the Israelites react?
Can you draw their faces in
verse 1? **Numbers 14:1-4**



Were the Israelites right to
react how they did?
Why or why not?
Numbers 14:11-12





LIVE IT OUT

Let's see what this means for us.



The giant people could have been very scary.
So, why were Joshua and Caleb not scared at all?? **Numbers 14:6-9**

What did Joshua and Caleb trust about God, that no-one else did?



Our mission isn't to spy out the land!
So, what is part of our mission as we trust Jesus?
Turn to 2 Corinthians 4:13

What scary things are there, at school, or at home which might make us not feel like trusting Jesus?



God hasn't promised us the land of Israel today!
So, what has God promised us then?
2 Corinthians 4:14-18

How can our strong God help us trust his promises,
so that we're not scared of anyone and so we live for him?
