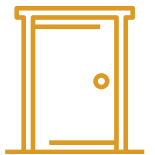

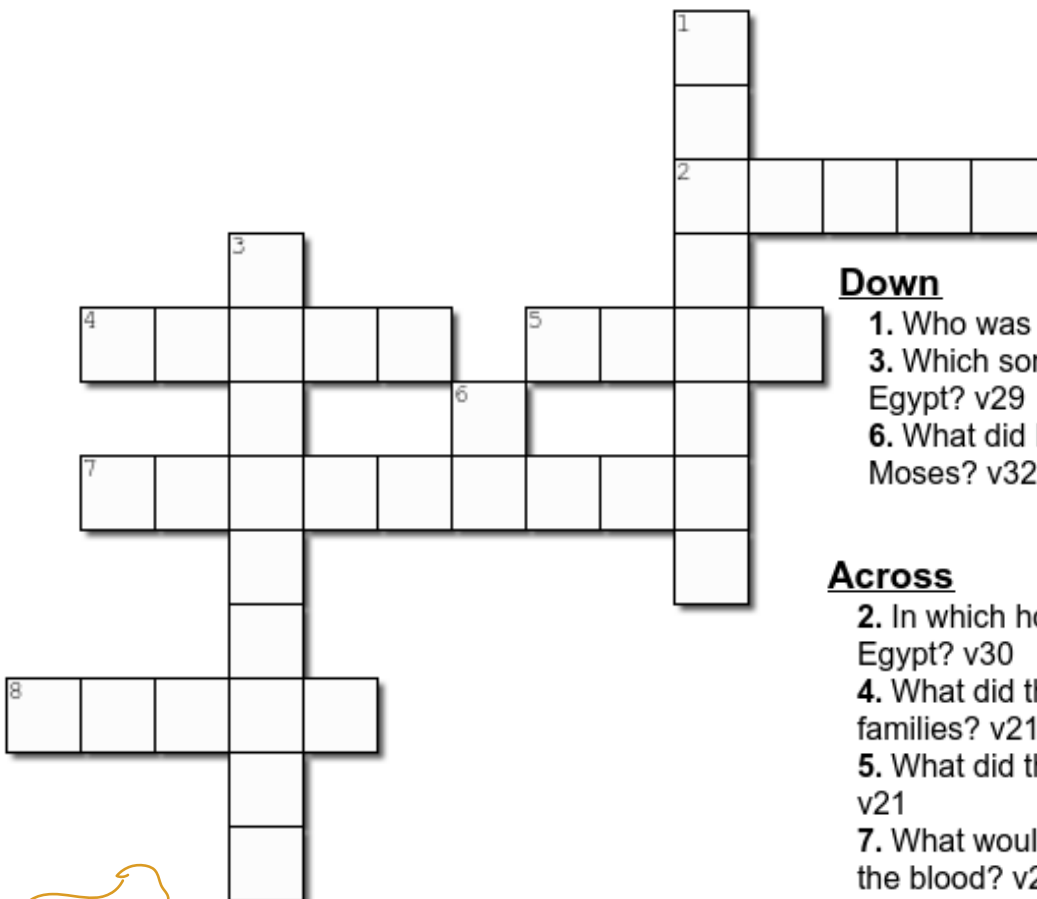


WORK IT OUT
