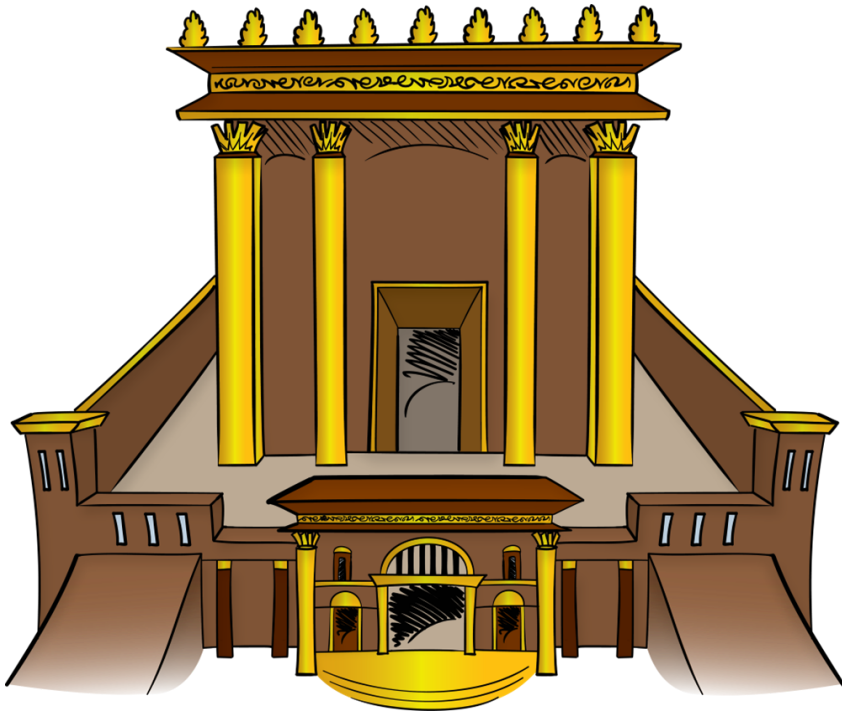
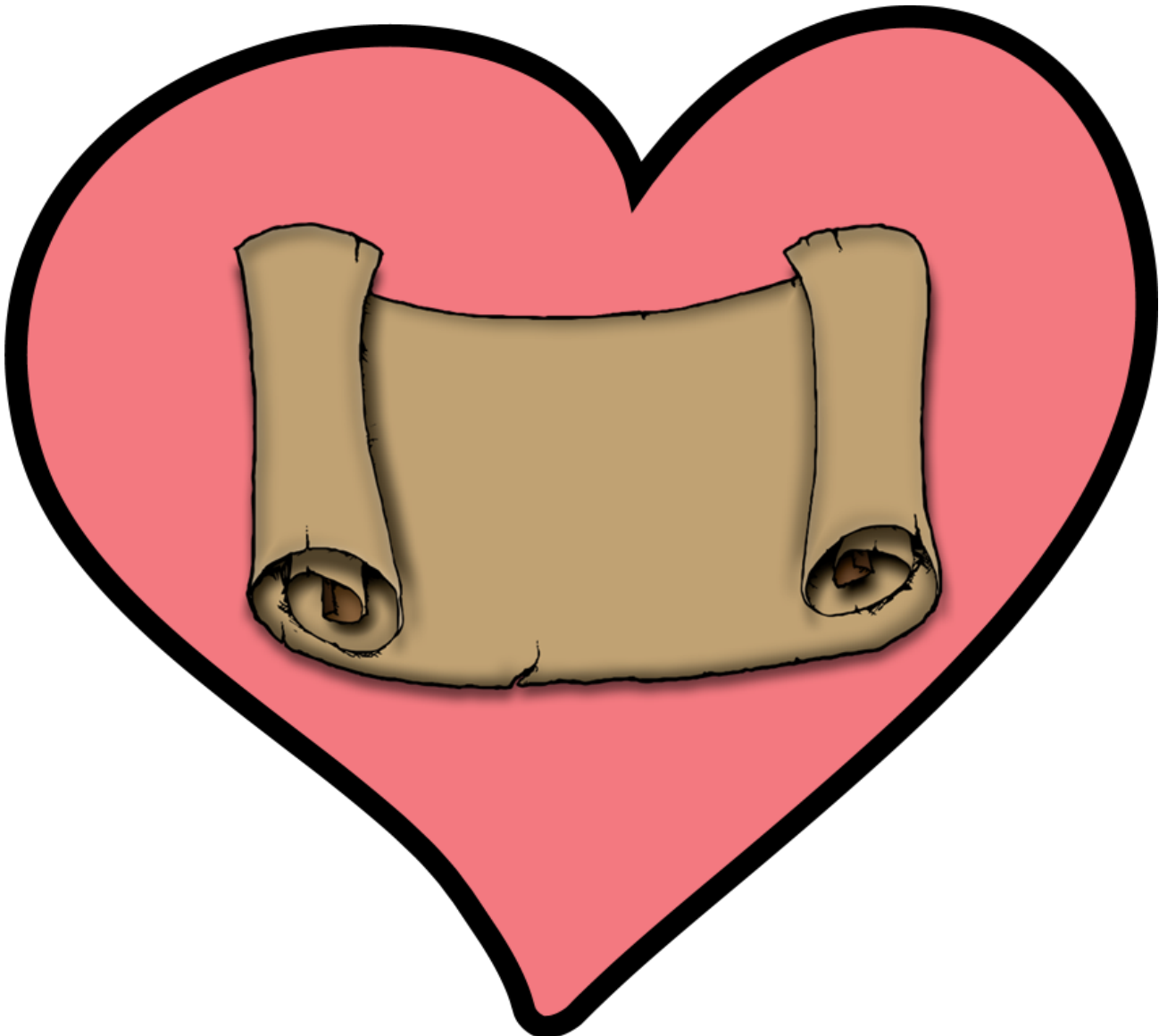


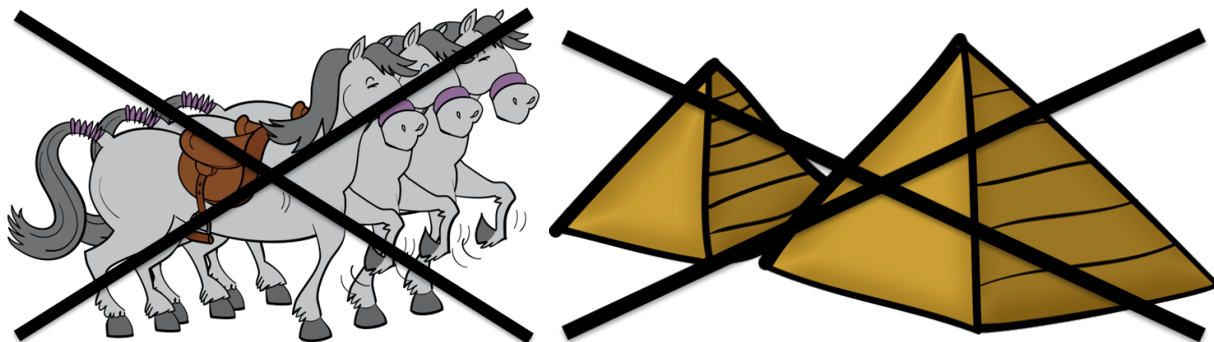

Solomon needed to love and obey God's law.



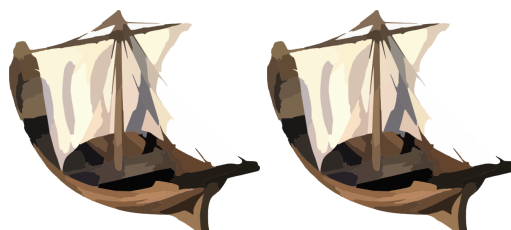
God's law said for kings: Don't have too many horses. Don't go back to Egypt.

Solomon obeyed God. He was very wise. God blessed the kingdom.



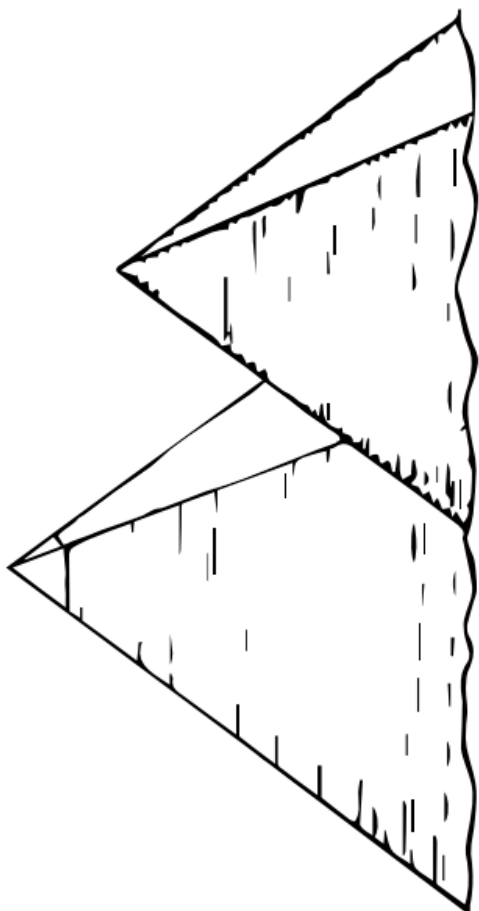
The people were all very happy.



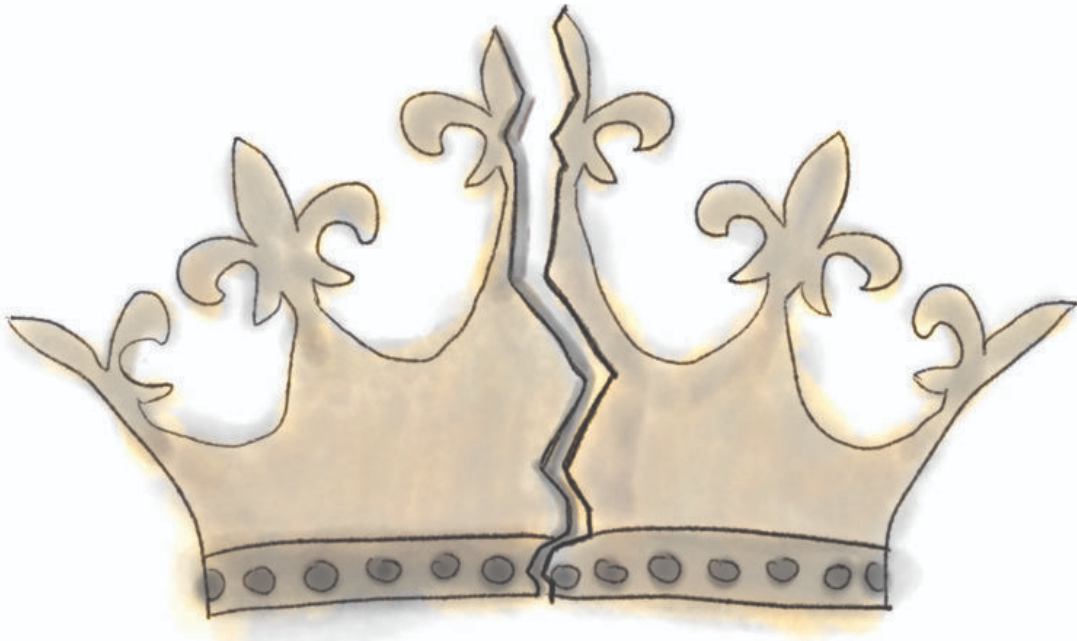
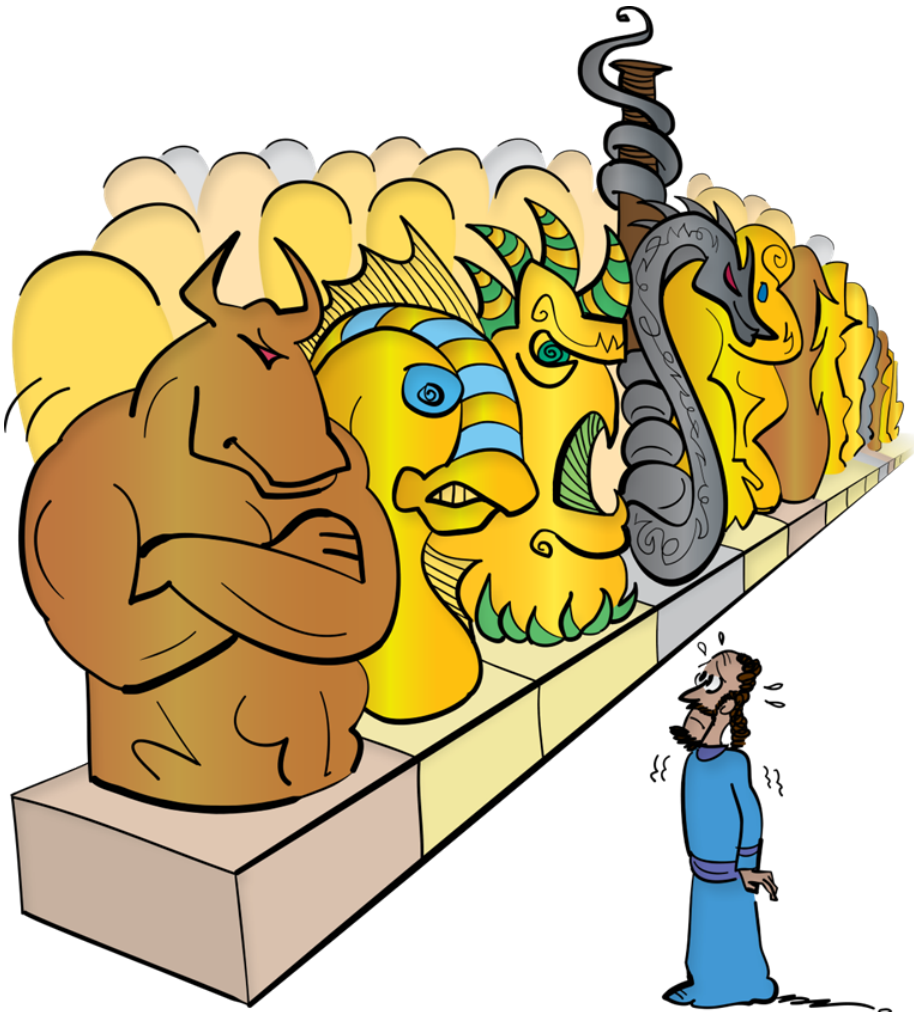
The Queen of Sheba saw all this, and was amazed! She praised God!



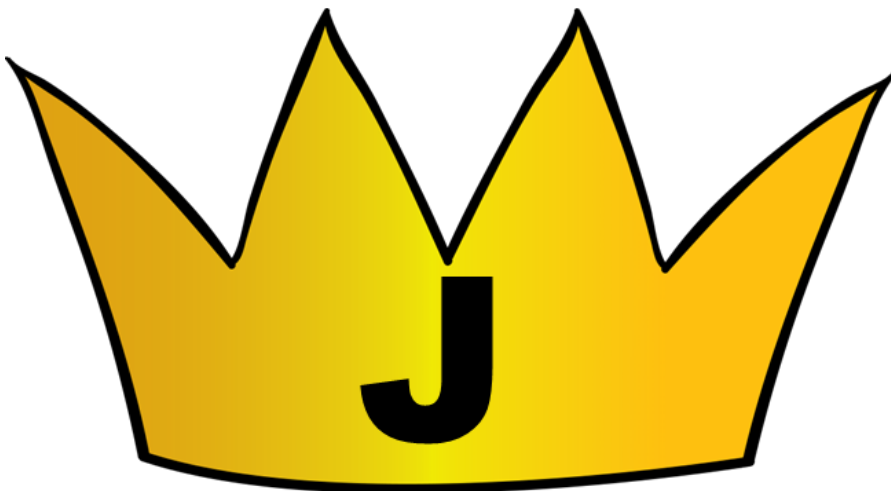
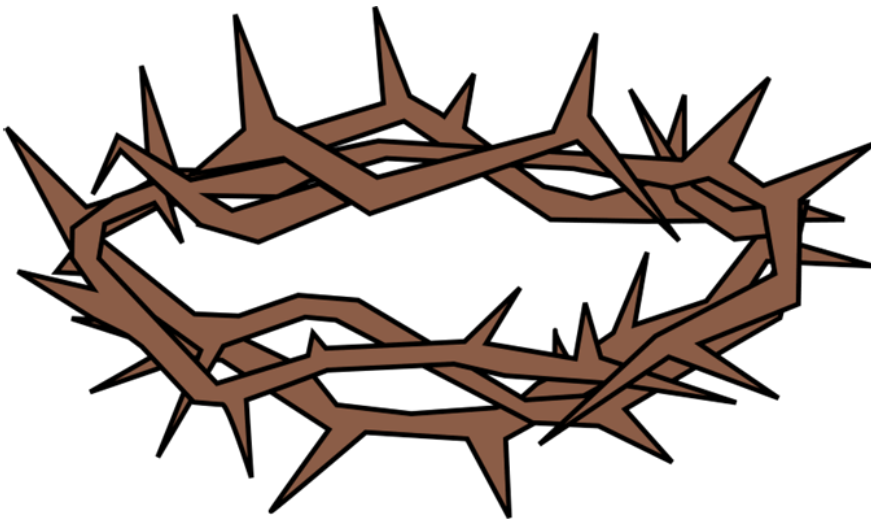
But then Solomon started forgetting about God, only a bit at first.
