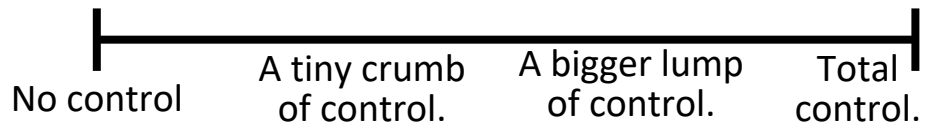


WORK IT OUT
